(i) Important safety note

"SCBS forward gear malfunction" is displayed on the instrument cluster

If the error message "SCBS / City emergency stop assistant forward gear malfunction" is displayed on the instrument cluster on the vehicle models mentioned above, one cause for this may be a defective boost pressure sensor.<shy /> The faulty signal can cause error entries in different control units.<shy /> In addition, the warning lamps for tyre pressure control, parking brake, I-Stop system and ABS may light up simultaneously.<shy /> The error can be reset briefly by switching the ignition off and on, but usually reappears after a short driving time.

<shy /> Control unit diagnostics<shy /> The following error codes may be stored in various system control units for this cause.

<shy /> Comfort control unit

- CAN connection for distance control system signal implausible ABS control unit
- U0401 CAN-BUS Invalid data Engine control unit
- P0471 Exhaust pressure sensor 1 (boost pressure sensor) function faulty <shy /> Repair advice<shy /> Continuing to drive with this defect can damage the engine. In addition, the deficiency causes hard shifting behaviour in vehicles with automatic transmission.<shy /> The vehicle manufacturer replaced the exhaust pressure sensor with a new modified component.<shy /> Within the scope of the repair, it must therefore be ensured that the old defective sensor is replaced by a new modified sensor (repair kit).<shy /> After the repair, the relevant error memory entries in the relevant control units must be deleted.<shy />
