## Renault Scenic | Grand Scenic - Replacing the cabin filter

Replacing the cabin filter is a little complex. It is located in the left-hand area of the passenger footwell. In order to access it, the glove compartment <span class="gallery-mode--link" data-order="1">(Fig. 1)</span> has to be removed.

To do this, please proceed as follows:

- Lever out the cover to the right of the glove compartment <span class="gallery-mode--link" data-order="2">(Fig. 2)</span>
- Remove the strip above the glove compartment <span class="gallery-mode--link" dataorder="3">(Fig.3)</span>
- Remove panelling on the left below the glove compartment <span class="gallery-mode--link" data-order="4">(Fig. 4)</span>
- Remove fastening screws on the glove compartment
- Take out glove compartment
- Remove the hose of the air duct <span class="gallery-mode--link" data-order="5">(Fig. 5)</span>

 After removing the cover, the filter is visible and freely accessible <span class="gallery-mode-link" data-order="6">(Fig. 6)</span>


## Remove the strip above the glove compartment
