Ford Galaxy 1,9 TDI and 2,8-CD-V6 Build up to 14.10.96 (Build code TY). Failure of the front wiper motor.

Wiper motor fails when switching on the A/C compressor.

Failure of the wiper motor, could be due to voltage spikes, which are produced by switching on the A/C compressor. To remedy, the wiper module (not the whole wiper motor) must replaced and an additional cable with a diode must be built in. The cable is to be fitted between the wiring harness and the magnetic clutch of the compressor.

Replace the wiper motor module

- 1. Dismantle the cover of the coolant expansion canister.
- 2. Dismantle the air baffle.
- 3. Remove the wiper motor module.
 - ⇒ Remove the plug from the module.
 - ⇒ Remove the screws (three).
- 4. Assembling the parts in reverse order using a new module.

Installing additional cable with diode

- 5. Raise the vehicle.
- 6. Remove engine bulkhead insulation.
- 7. Remove the plug from the compressor clutch.
- 8. Connect the additional with the wiring harness and the magnetic clutch of the compressor.
- 9. Fixed the additional cable, using a cable tie, to the cable clip of the for operation.
- 10. Fasten the bulkhead insulation again.
- 11. Check the wiper motor on function.
