Ford Mondeo Model year 2001

Central locking system does not work properly.

If there are complaints with these vehicles that the central locking system is not working properly, one possible cause could be one or more faulty door locks. In this case, a weak spring on the micro-switch in the door lock, and possible humidity penetration in the connection plug, could be causing the problem. The lock in the driver's door is responsible for the central locking function. To eliminate the fault, observe the problem and then proceed accordingly:

- The doors cannot be locked using the remote control although the servo motors can be heard and are working. Cause of the fault: door lock on the driver's side, replace the lock.
- One or more doors lock and unlock independently during driving. Cause of the fault: door lock on the driver's side, replace the lock.
- The doors can be locked using the remote control, but one or more doors remain unlocked. Cause of the fault: door lock on the door affected, replace the lock.

The connection plug for the door locks affected should be checked for humidity. If necessary, dry the plug and apply a sealing agent.
