



Lancia Lybra Model year from 2001 to 2005

Airbag warning light comes on

If there are complaints about the above-mentioned fault, contact problems could be the cause. In addition, the fault "Value too high/open circuit" is stored in the fault memory. In this case, the plug connections of all airbags (driver and front passenger airbag as well as the head airbags on both sides) have to be checked. These can become loose due to vibrations, thus causing the above-mentioned fault.

Proceed as follows:

- Remove glove compartment to reach the yellow multiple plug on the airbag wiring harness.
- Fix the multiple plug and wiring harness of the airbag using cable clips (see Fig. 1).
- The multiple plugs for the head airbags are in the lower part of the C-pillars.
- Here again, fix the multiple plugs and the wiring harness using cable clips (see Fig. 2).
- Reinstall removed parts in reverse order.
- Delete fault memory.

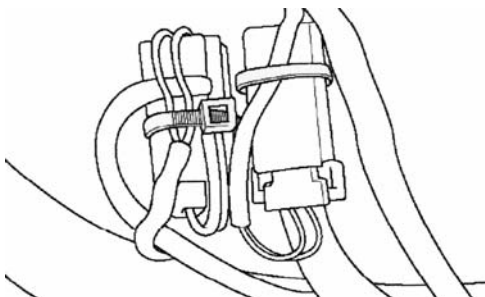

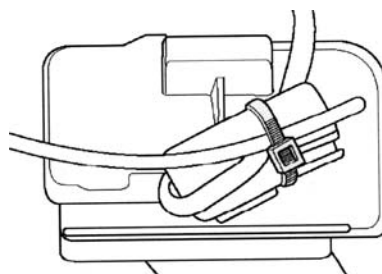
